frequently asked QUESTIONS



WHO SHOULD JOIN A TWO WHEEL VIEW TRIP?

TWO WHEEL VIEW student and school programs are designed for positive, levelheaded students and teachers with a keen interest in experiential learning and international travel. We offer programs for students from 14 - 17 years old. Our programs are not suitable for students with significant behavioral problems or the inability to work constructively in a team environment.

WHAT'S THE GROUP SIZE?

A typical trip group size is 10 students and three adult trip leaders. Student groups are made up of participants from the USA, Canada and the countries we visit. Students may apply on their own or as part of a larger school group (eight youth comprise a school group).

DO I NEED SPECIAL SKILLS TO JOIN A TRIP?

Students join us from a variety of backgrounds and bring with them a mix of skills and experiences. Although most students that go on trips have never been mountain bike touring, you need to be physically active, know how to ride a bicycle and be open to camping and outdoor experiences.

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE PROGRAM FEE OF MY TRIP?

TWO WHEEL VIEW bicycle expedition programs include all bicycle touring equipment, camping gear, outerwear if necessary, activities, and admission fees as specified in the trip itinerary. We also include all accommodation and meals. Personal items such as souvenirs, laundry, internet, snacks, and phone calls are not included in the price of the trip.

WILL TWO WHEEL VIEW ORGANIZE MY FLIGHT?

Yes! TWO WHEEL VIEW will coordinate all of your travel plans from the city of your choice. We offer a number of travel options for students and will coordinate all travel for you or your group. Contact us for details.

ADVENTUROUS
